Meeting called to order at 4:32PM by Mr. Shawn Apple.

- b. Public Health Principles & Governance ( 19 min. March )**

**Karen Clark** -We are in the “black”. Expenses increased over last month as expected. Majority of expense is grant related, along with State Transmittal quarterly expense.

**Jamie Elenz** – We attended a WIC event and distributed 20 cribs for our safe Sleep Program. Have completed all the scheduled vaccine assessments for the Get Vaccinated grant.

**Laura Fauss** – Stated the Sewage program is picking up since the weather is breaking. Also discussed we have two unpaid interns from out of state who will work in our Tick and Mosquito programs. They will also be interviewing another unpaid intern in May.

**Lori Barnes** – Stated food inspections are on track. Overall permits are down except wells. Will be working to complete pool and camp inspections next month. Went to Valley View to find they were selling milk. Have again blocked off the food section. Has been an ownership change and we are working with the new owners and attorneys to get a new license issued. Noted that Damascus Livestock has applied for a food license and appears to now be OK with our fees and rules.

**Wes Vins** – Stated we have received an EFT for over \$78,000 from ODH reimbursing us for food fee losses due to the pandemic. Advised we have received the Community Health Assessment and a draft copy should be to the Board at our May meeting.

**Violation –** Misc. solid waste, litter, tires, dwelling, vehicles and boat with openings creating nuisance conditions.

**ORC 3707.01** The Board of Health of a city or general health district shall abate and remove all nuisances within its jurisdiction. It may, by order, compel the owners, agents, assignees, occupants or tenants of any lot, property, building or structure to abate and remove any nuisance therein, and prosecute such persons for neglect or refusal to obey such orders.

**Correction –** Remove all solid waste, litter and tires from property and dispose of to a licensed facility. Secure dwelling, vehicles and boat.

**Violation –** Off lot septic distance requirements

**OAC 3701-29-06 (G) (3) (b) & (e) –** All STS components shall be 50' from any surface water (stream) and 50' from any water supply.

**Recommendation:** Approval. Lot constraints, but installer was able to get 40' from well & 15-20' from stream.

**Motion to approve** by Mr. Dailey, second by Mr. Rose. Roll call vote: Mr. Dailey – yes, Mr. Apple - yes, Mr. Haugh – yes, Dr. Jackson – yes and Mr. Rose - yes.

Address of Violation: 18121 Fife Coal Road, Wellsville OH 43968

OAC 3701-29-01 – Household sewage treatment system – Any STS that receives sewage from a single family, two family or three family dwelling

Recommendation: Approval due to health conditions provided per doctor and non-permanent configuration.

**D. H2OHIO BID EXTENSIONS** - Ms. Barnes stated Wind Turbines is requesting an extension on Bids 1 & 3 due to weather conditions.

Request that our Nursing Fee Schedule shall continually update to Vaxcare pricing, with the exceptions of the \$15 administration fee as set by Medicaid.

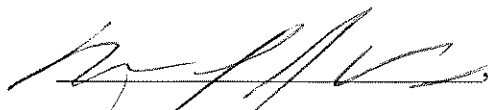
