The Coronavirus Delta variant has been spreading across the country, and is known to have been in Ohio for several months. This variant is reported to be more contagious than the previous version of the virus.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, preliminary data from several states over the last few months suggest that 99.5% of COVID-19 in the United States occurred among unvaccinated people. With the low vaccination rates in Columbian County of 35% fully vaccinated, our community could again see an increase in illness from this virus.

Since COVID-19 vaccines offer a high rate of protection against Delta hospitalization and death, CCHD continues to recommend that residents receive their COVID vaccine. There is currently no shortage of Janssen (J&J), Modera or Pfizer vaccines in Columbiana County.
