

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM MANAGER (Full time, permanent): The Columbiana County Health District is accepting applications for an Environmental Health Program Manager who is responsible for the execution of assigned Health District programs including but not limited to community service, outreach, enforcement of local and state codes, education, supervising program staff, and tracking activities/data. The position will manage and complete program deliverables as necessary as well as other special assignments

Applicants must have applicable experience or education, at least 10 years of experience working in local public health, hold registration in the State of Ohio as an Environmental Health Specialist and a Master's Degree applicable to public health, or be in the process of degree obtainment. Possess the ability to communicate with large or small groups through written or oral presentations. Have proficiency in use of Windows Office products. Maintain credentials to satisfy program requirements and possess the skills necessary to relate to people of diverse ages, cultures and socio-economics. Possesses a valid driver's license and must maintain liability insurance on personal vehicle for carrying out job duties.

A successful applicant will work independently, and be able to interact effectively with groups and the public. A background check is required and drug testing may be required. The position will focus on environmental health, but may also have responsibilities in other public health programs.
