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Columbiana County Health District will be providing a Moderna drive-thru COVID-19 booster vaccination clinic to those eligible on Monday and Wednesday, November 8 & 10, 2021, at the Columbiana County Vaccination Complex in the Columbiana County Fairgrounds.

Pre-registration is required. You can register by calling one of our dedicated phone lines, 330-420-5580 or 330-420-5454, starting on Wednesday, November 3, 2021, at 1:00 PM to speak with a scheduling specialist.

Those who received an initial series of either Pfizer/Comirnaty or Moderna and are currently eligible include those who meet any of the following criteria:

- 65 years and older.
- Age 18 and older who live in long-term care settings.
- Age 18 and older who have underlying medical conditions.
- Age 18 and older who work or live in high-risk settings.

Eligible individuals may choose which vaccine they receive as a booster dose. CDC's recommendations now allow for this type of mix-and-match dosing for booster shots. So, for example, if you received your first two doses (both Pfizer/Comirnaty, or both Moderna) at least six months ago and are eligible for a booster, you can now choose any of the three available vaccines for a booster: Pfizer/Comirnaty, Moderna, or Johnson & Johnson. If you received the single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine at least two months ago, you can now choose any of the three available COVID-19 vaccines as a booster: Pfizer/Comirnaty, Moderna, or Johnson & Johnson. These clinics will only be offering the Moderna booster.

The clinic will begin at 9:00 AM through the main fairground entrance at: 225 Lee Avenue, Lisbon, OH 44432. The clinic will operate from 9:00 AM- 3:30 PM.

There is no cost for the vaccine and proof of insurance is not required. If available, please bring your original vaccine card, if you do not have your original card, you will be provided a new card which will only include the booster information. Proof of identification in the form of a driver's license, state ID, or another form of identification that includes a birthdate is required.

Attendees should wear something comfortable that allows easy access to their upper arm, where they will receive the vaccine. There will be no changing facilities available on site.

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
